

Continue to reward your dog for a while ever ter they're housetrained so that you maintain the association that going in the right place is a great thing!



Contrary to popular belief, dogs do not know that it is "wrong" to use the bathroom indoors. Housetraining is more like a habit that our dogs develop by continually using the bathroom in the same place. If we want our dogs to only go outside or on a pee pad, it's up to us to help them create and maintain that habit. Once trained, your dog will prefer to go in the right spot.
